## **“The Where and When for Adjunctive Therapy”**



Locally administrated antimicrobials have found their way into the mainstream treatment of periodontal disease. These products have their place in the treatment and control of the disease but are misunderstood and wrongly prescribed for many patients. Dr. Lambert will seek to unravel the mystery surrounding this modality and will review the advantages and disadvantages of the current products on the market. Dr. Lambert will help hygienists understand where LAAs can be effective and where they will not be effective. Dr. Lambert discusses the decision making matrix, the technique, and the evaluation of results. Dr. Lambert will discuss Arestin, Periochip, Periostat, Peridex, and Perio Protect. He will touch on motivation, the language of persuasion, and the advantages and disadvantages of incorporating this modality into the general practice.

This lecture will be a review the terminology used to describe lesions of the jaws. A comprehensive review of common benign and malignant lesions will be discussed.

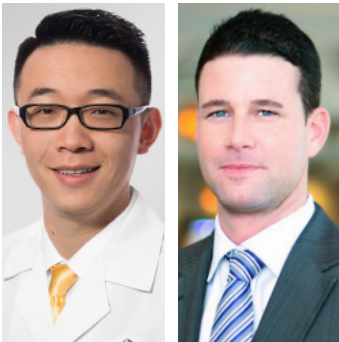
- Radiographic description of jaw lesions: Lucent, opaque and mixed

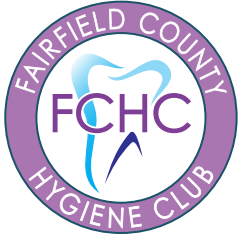

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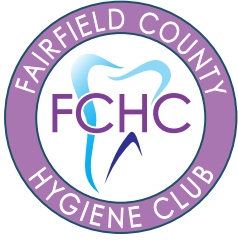
