"New AAP Periodontal classification system"

“AAO - Accelerated Osteogenic Orthodontics”



This course will provide attendees with an in-depth knowledge about Accelerated Osteogenic Orthodontics, or AOO. The instructor will review the Regional Acceleratory Phenomenon (RAP) and how it allows an orthodontist to move teeth faster, thus shortening treatment time. A variety of treatment modalities and appliances will be presented which allow a clinician to accomplish this. The instructor will also discuss how AOO incorporates the addition of a bone graft, and how this provides patients with additional benefits, including more conservative and esthetic orthodontic treatment outcomes, and healthier post-treatment periodontal health.

The goal of this workshop is to explain why the orthodontic patient benefits from a multidisciplinary treatment approach, and to provide the attendees with the knowledge to educate their patients about the importance of periodontal health when considering orthodontic treatment.
