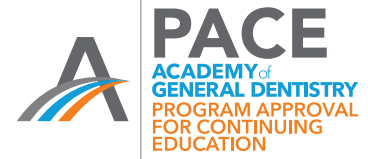

ESTHETIC IMPLANT THERAPY:

Multidisciplinary approaches to a true clinical challenge

The world of implant dentistry has changed over time; patients are far more demanding today than many years ago, they do not expect a simple implant crown to substitute a missing tooth. They expect it to look just like a natural tooth. The clinician must understand the importance of interim restorations and design them adequately to condition the tissues to create natural-looking emergence profiles on dental implants.

Material selection, abutment design, and delivery techniques also play a crucial role in increasing implant therapy predictability. In this program, the clinician will be exposed to a four-step approach to diagnose, treatment plan, and execute implant cases in an organized and straightforward manner to increase their success in this type of therapy.

**MECHANICAL STRATEGIES FOR IMPLANT ASSISTED
AND SUPPORTED COMPLETE PROSTHESES**

Treatment of the completely edentulous patient has always proven to be one of the most challenging aspects of clinical dentistry. When treating the edentulous patient, dental clinicians are faced with many questions: Where do I get started? What prosthetic design is most appropriate for my patient?

This presentation will take you through the steps necessary in diagnosing, treatment planning and predictably treating the edentulous patient with endosseous dental implants. Mechanical strategies, case design, attachment mechanisms, CAD/CAM bars and clinical procedures will be discussed in detail.

**ABUTMENT CONFIGURATION AND
PERI-IMPLANT TISSUES**

Peri-implant bone remodeling after implant placement is a physiological process that occurs as a part of the establishment of peri-implant biologic width. Several attempts have been made to minimize the amount of peri-implant bone remodeling. In this lecture it will be presented that other factors such as the abutment geometry could also influence the amount of peri-implant bone remodeling. Additionally, CAD-CAM technology could be used to design appropriate abutment configuration in order to favor the peri-implant soft tissue adaptation and reduce bone remodeling.

FULL MOUTH REHABILITATION**

Many clinicians find it difficult to plan and sequence the complex dental restoration. Dr. Smith will outline a systematic method to simplify restoration of these cases. 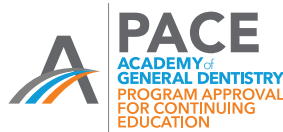
